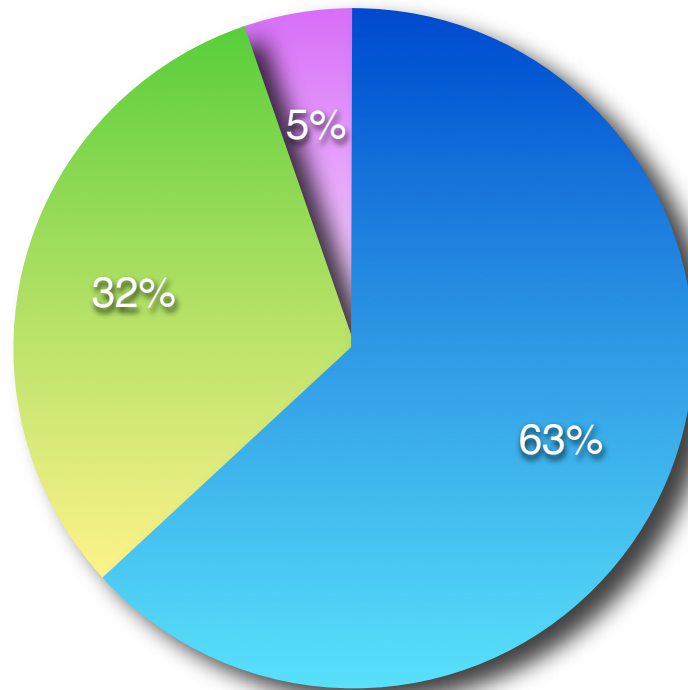


## Analysis of Evaluation Sheets Speed Reading - Phil Chambers
