

CETC MIDLANDS STUDENTS EXCEL IN EXAMS

CIPFA students studying at CETC Midlands have achieved fantastic results in the December 2006 Professional Accountancy Qualification (PAQ) exams.

Highlights of CETC Midlands results include (the percentages in brackets are the overall CIPFA average pass rates):

- Several high scoring papers, including:
 - Financial Accounting – **100%** (67%)
 - Accounting for Decision Making – **86%** (64%)
 - Financial & Performance Reporting – **77%** (59%)
 - Governance & Public Policy – **77%** (60%)
 - Financial Reporting – **71%** (54%)
- CETC Midlands students sitting the final two papers – Finance & Management Case Study and Strategic Business Management scored an impressive **91%** and **82%** respectively. This compares to 65% and 62% CIPFA averages.

CETC also provides bespoke fast track courses, which are attended by students from KPMG and PwC, as well as being open to students from other firms and employers. These students again achieved outstanding results as follows:

- **100%** (65%) - Finance & Management Case Study
- **100%** (62%) - Strategic Business Management

Chris Lees, Course Director at CETC Midlands, says: "The pass rates achieved by CETC Midlands students are fantastic and they should be extremely proud. The results are a credit to their hard work and praise must also go to the employers who have supported their trainees. The performance of CETC students in the recent exams goes to show that our courses still offer the best method for passing the CIPFA exams."
